Prior Knowledge

- Can recognise and name different colours.
- Understands that when colours are mixed, new colours are created.
- Can select and create different colours.
 - Uses a variety of tools to apply paint, e.g. brushes of different sizes, sponges, fingers, objects.
 - Can begin to identify primary colours
 - Can work from direct observation and imagination.

- Explore and develop control with a variety of tools.
- Know the name of the primary and secondary colours.
- Begin to know the names of the secondary colours.
- Explore darkening and lightning colours by adding black or white paint.
- Ask questions about other artist's work.
