Pupil Premium Funding - this is a central government grant to help us ensure that all groups of children have the opportunity to achieve well. Funding is linked to the number of pupils who are eligible to receive free school meals and aims to support those pupils who are identified as being disadvantaged. This also includes additional funding for children who are Looked After and Previously Looked After. Children from families who serve in the armed forces are also entitled to receive Service Pupil Premium.
