Earlier this week, School Governors, Tom Wilkinson and Dave Marshall, met myself and representatives from NY Police to discuss the school Street Pilot Scheme still in force on Bell Close. The police have agreed to commit officers to police the scheme and have also asked me to remind parents that **if you have a blue badge or a permit, it should be clearly displayed** if you drive into Bell Close between 8.15 and 9.00am; and 3.00-3.45pm. Without a permit or blue badge, it is an offence to be in Bell Close between these times – please abide by the law to help keep our children safe.
