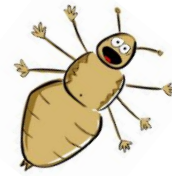
Next Tuesday will be the last week of netball club as the evenings are quickly drawing in. Netball club has been a huge success and enjoyed by all who have taken

Head Lice

We are writing to inform parents that head lice cases have been identified in school. While lice are nothing more than a nuisance, it is important that children are checked on a weekly basis so that any head lice can be dealt with quickly and before they spread.

Please check your child's head as soon as possible.

HEAD LICE (NITS) This is a very common and recurring problem in all schools. Wet combing with conditioner is the advised treatment but this needs to be carried out daily and thoroughly for it to be effective.
