As we start the new term, I also thought it would be useful to take this opportunity to share a few reminders and clarify a couple of key points:

Uniform - Sportswear is not acceptable for school wear. The children may wear smart black or brown footwear but fluorescent/bright coloured trainers are not allowed. For PE activities children will require a blue or white T-shirt and blue/navy shorts (no 'beach style' wear and no hot-pants please). Children are not permitted to wear jewellery for PE.

Boys (required)

- Grey/black trousers.
- White polo shirt or shirt.
- Royal blue sweatshirt with or without school badge.

Girls (required)

- Grey/black trousers/skirt/dress (or blue checked dress).
- White polo shirt/shirt/blouse.
- Royal blue sweatshirt with or without school badge.

Make-up should not be worn and jewellery should be kept to an absolute minimum.

Toys – Toys should not be brought into school unless they are part of an education health care plan or individual learning plan (or part of a special arrangement by the class teacher e.g. an end of term games day).

Parking – I am delighted that North Yorkshire Highways have agreed to make the School Street Pilot Scheme a permanent road traffic order. This came into force on 19th April. This means that the Police will issue fines to anyone without a blue badge or permit who is caught in Bell Close between 8.15am and 9.00am; and 3.00pm and 3.45pm.
