Attendance – We complete this half-term with an attendance figure of 95.9% across all year groups, just slightly short of our 96% target. However, I am all too aware that a number of nasty bugs have been doing the rounds. At the end of next half-term, letters will be sent out to all parents where attendance falls below 90%, this is classed as persistent absenteeism by the DfE and support will be offered to help improve attendance – this equates to 7 days of absence between September and December.
