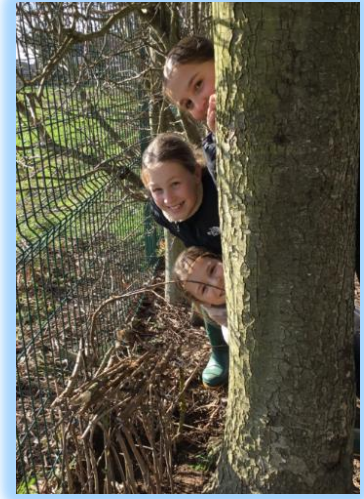

Meanwhile, Year 6 pupils launched their topic which covers World War 2. This work was linked to work in forest school on shelters.

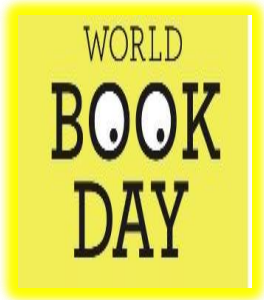
