



Off on a woodland adventure?

Try your hand at stick weaving while you're there!

Before you go, grab a handful of wool or string – you'll need this later. Look out for forked sticks. When you find one, wind the wool or string it in a zig zag from one side of the fork to the other.

Now keep your eyes peeled for fallen leaves, winged seeds and smaller, bendy twigs.

> Weave them into your wool – what have you captured in your woodland net?

Try using different coloured wool and weaving with lots of sticks.
