Learning Journeys

Our teachers use the analogy of a journey when they plan sequences of learning each half-term. Each half-term is the beginning of a new learning journey. Each learning journey begins with a launch event and is boosted by a trip; event; or visitor later in the half-term. Each learning journey ends when it reaches its 'destination': usually an event or a performance. This week has certainly seen some exciting learning journeys being launched.

Pop-in parents' evening – Don't forget to pop-in and meet your child's new class teacher at next week's pop-in parents' evening, Thursday 19th September, 3.40-4.40. No appointment is necessary. This is an informal opportunity to find out more about how your child has settled



in, see some of the work they have done so far and ask any questions or share any concerns you may have.

As the new academic year is now well underway, I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of a few important points that will help ensure a successful, smooth and safe experience for our whole school community:

1. Road Safety – Please be aware that it is an offence for motorised vehicles to enter Bell Close during term time between 8.15 and 9.00am; and 3.00-3.45pm with the

exception of permit holders and blue badge holders. Please support this scheme to help keep our children safe (as well as avoiding a fine).

With kind permission by the Copper Horse and the Mayfield, we have a park and stride system in place whereby parents may use their carparks during school-drop off and pick-up times.

We also have a voluntary one-way system to avoid congestion on Denison Avenue. If driving to school is unavoidable, please enter Denison Avenue from the Pasture Lane end and Exit Denison Avenue at the Abbots Garth End.

2. Website/Twitter/DoJo - You can find the most up to date information about the school, policies and your child's learning by visiting the school website. - **3. Dogs are not permitted on the school site** whether they are on a lead or being carried. Many of our children are uncomfortable around unfamiliar dogs and many have allergies.

However, we do ask parents and carers to help us reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer an anaphylactic reaction if exposed to nuts as far as possible. Please do not send in any nut-based foods: loose nuts, peanut butter or other nut butters, chocolate spreads, cakes and biscuits that contain nuts or any other products where any type of nut are listed in the ingredients. If you think your child has a nut allergy, or any other type of allergy, please report this to the school office as soon as possible.
